Where did you intern this past summer and what was your role?

This past summer I had the opportunity to intern with Crews & Associates in Little Rock, Arkansas. Why did you choose to become a CPA

While you are in school, you are already in the routines and habits that will make studying for the CPA more manageable. Breaking out a set time in your busy schedule to study was what worked for me. This way you can get the studying in and not feel any guilt or stress trying to cram it in when you find time. Even when it gets tough, it is important that you just keep going. The exam is a marathon, and to finish, you have to put in the work and just keep going.
