

ARCPA Seeking Social Media Intern

Arkansas Society of CPAs is seeking one student as a Social Media Intern. This student will earn a \$2,500 stipend after successfully completing the internship period. The Social Media Intern will work directly with the Director of Public Relations & Communications,

and report to the Executive Director, to:

- Write short, descriptive, engaging content for social media (Twitter, Facebook & LinkedIn)
- * Conduct research and interviews for stories, and blogs.
 - Write, edit, and proofread articles and promos for publications, releases, website, emails, e-newsletters, marketing, etc.
- * Create social media images, graphics, ads and flyers
- * Edit and format photos for various social media and publications.
- * Film short video clips (interviews, promos, etc.).
- * Work with staff to create content ideas and maintain a monthly social media calendar
- * Repurpose content from other sources for our own social media channels (and understand how to change the tone for audience).
- * Understand and monitor social media analytics and website analytics (a plus).
- * Other duties as assigned

Must be able to commit at least 15 hours per week for a period of 15 weeks. (Preferred period to begin <u>January 10</u> <u>and end on May 8, 2020</u>). At the end of the internship position a \$2,500 stipend will be paid. Amount will be pro-rated if student is unable to work the full 15 week period.

Must be a current student pursuing a degree in Marketing or Communication with a minimum of 30 credit hours. Should possess excellent written and verbal communication skills. Experience using AP style. Strong MS Office skills and Adobe InDesign preferred. Strong understanding of social media. Experience with creating videos preferred. Knowledge of HTML, web publishing/design a plus.
